This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day 1 after 2 it shall have become a law; provided that the commissioner of the 3 department of transportation shall notify the legislative bill drafting 4 commission upon the occurrence of the provisions of section two of this 5 act in order that the commission may maintain an accurate data base of 6 the official text of the laws of the state of New York in furtherance of 7 effecting the provisions of section 44 of the legislative law and 8 section 70-b of the public officers law; and effective immediately, the 9 addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary 10 for the implementation of this act on its effective date is authorized 11 to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
