9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Corporation Commission; making
11 an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 providing budgetary limitations; requiring certain
15 budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget
16 procedures; providing lapse dates; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Corporation
20 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
21 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2018, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
23 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
24 the Corporation Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the
 2 Corporation Commission shall budget all funds in the following
 3 categories and amounts:

16 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 17 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 18 upon the Corporation Commission by law shall be set by the General
 19 Administrator. The Corporation Commission shall be subject to the
 20 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
 21 and expenditures excluding direct expenditures for well plugging as
 22 authorized in Section 310 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes, pit
 23 closure as authorized in Section 140 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma
 24 Statutes, and remediation of sites as authorized in Section 353 of

1 Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and as may be authorized pursuant
2 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
3 Statutes:

7 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
8 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
9 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be
10 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).
11 Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,
12 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds
13 remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall
14 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
15 year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June
16 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse
17 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
18 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
19 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay
20 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after
21 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
22 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
23 from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been
24 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
