AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to $providing \ that \ one \ hundred \ percent \ of \ in\text{-state sales of new}$ passenger

cars and trucks shall be zero-emissions by two thousand thirty-five

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-

bly, do enact as follows:

- $\ 1$ $\$ Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by $\$ adding a
 - 2 new section 19-0306-b to read as follows:
 - 3 § 19-0306-b. Zero-emissions cars and trucks.
- 4 1. It shall be a goal of the state that one hundred percent of
- 5 $\,$ in-state sales of new passenger cars and trucks shall be $\,$ zero-emissions

- 7 $\,$ that one hundred percent of medium-duty and heavy-duty vehicles $\,$ in the
