29 (2) The deployment, implementation, or use of a motor
30 carrier safety improvement by or as required by a motor carrier,
31 its related entity, or a third party, including by contract, may
32 not be considered when evaluating an individual's status as a
33 motor carrier employee or independent contractor, or as a
34 jointly employed employee, under any state law.

35 (3) This section does not exempt an owner or driver of a
36 commercial motor vehicle from complying with s. 316.302 and any
37 rule or regulation adopted thereunder.

38 Section 2. Section 320.0602, Florida Statutes, is created
39 to read:

40 320.0602 International Registration Plan; commercial motor
41 vehicle license plates and cab cards.—Notwithstanding s. 320.06,
42 beginning October 1, 2023, a commercial motor vehicle that is
43 operated by a motor carrier and registered in accordance with
44 the International Registration Plan shall be issued a license
45 plate that is valid for 5 years and an annual cab card denoting
46 the declared gross vehicle weight. The license plate shall be
47 issued based on the applicant's appropriate renewal period.

48 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
