SYNOPSIS

Requires commercial motor vehicles to be equipped with certain global positioning systems.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

1 AN ACT concerning commercial motor vehicle global positioning
2 systems and supplementing Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. A commercial motor vehicle, as defined in section 3 of
8 P.L.1990, c.103 (C. 39:3-10.11), operating upon the public
9 highways of this State shall be equipped with a global positioning
10 system navigation program that shall provide:

11 a. information about upcoming highway infrastructure with
12 low vertical clearance and weight restrictions; and

13 b. dynamic route directions that account for commercial motor
14 vehicle restrictions based upon the specific height and weight of the
15 commercial motor vehicle when entered by the driver.

17 2. The Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle
18 Commission shall adopt, pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure
19 Act,” P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), rules and regulations to
20 effectuate the purposes of this act.

22 3. This act shall take effect immediately but shall remain
23 inoperative until 180 days after the date of enactment.

STATEMENT

28 This bill requires a commercial motor vehicle operating upon the
29 public highways of this State to be equipped with a global
30 positioning system navigation program that provides information
31 about upcoming highway infrastructure with low vertical clearance
32 and weight restrictions and dynamic route directions that account
33 for commercial motor vehicle restrictions.
