AN ACT CONCERNING THE PHASE-IN AND RATE OF THE TAX ON FUELS AND GASOHOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That (1) the phase-in of the tax on fuels and gasohol pursuant to
- 2 section 1 of public act 22-1 of the November special session be delayed
- 3 for six months, and (2) the Department of Revenue Services and the
- 4 Office of Policy and Management be required to make a joint
- 5 recommendation to the finance, revenue and bonding committee as to
- 6 the appropriate rate of such tax to ensure the state maintains its surface
- 7 transportation infrastructure in good repair.

Statement of Purpose:

To delay the phase-in of the tax on fuels and gasohol by six months and require the Department of Revenue Services and the Office of Policy and Management make a joint recommendation as to the appropriate rate of such tax to ensure the state maintains its surface transportation infrastructure in good repair.
