For the purposes of this subsection, a railroad utility employee is not 10 considered a crew member. 11 12 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to the operation of a train or light engine for hostler service. 13 14 (c) A railroad company that violates this section is liable to the state for a civil penalty of: 15 16 (1) not less than \$250 or more than \$1,000 for a first 17 violation; 18 (2) not less than \$1,000 or more than \$5,000 for a second violation in a period of three years or less; or 19 (3) not less than \$5,000 or more than \$10,000 for a 20 21 third or subsequent violation in a period of three years or less. 22 (d) Suit for a civil penalty under Subsection (c) may be 23 brought in Travis County or in any county in or through which the 24 railroad is operated, by:

(1) the attorney general or an attorney acting under
 2 the direction of the attorney general; or

3 (2) the county or district attorney in any county in or
4 through which the railroad is operated.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
