A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to weight limitations for liquefied petroleum gas motor  
3 vehicles.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 621.101(b-1), Transportation Code, is  
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b-1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,  
8 a vehicle or combination of vehicles that is powered by an engine  
9 fueled primarily or secondarily by natural gas or liquefied  
10 petroleum gas may exceed any weight limitation under this section  
11 by an amount that is equal to the difference between the weight of  
12 the vehicle attributable to the natural gas or liquefied petroleum  
13 gas tank and fueling system carried by that vehicle and the weight  
14 of a comparable diesel tank and fueling system, provided that the  
15 maximum gross weight of the vehicle or combination of vehicles may  
16 not exceed 81,000 [~~82,000~~] pounds.

17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
