- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 621.101(b-1), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
- 8 a vehicle or combination of vehicles that is powered by an engine
- 9 fueled primarily or secondarily by natural gas or liquefied
- 10 petroleum gas may exceed any weight limitation under this section
- 11 by an amount that is equal to the difference between the weight of
- 12 the vehicle attributable to the natural gas or liquefied petroleum
- 13 gas tank and fueling system carried by that vehicle and the weight
- 14 of a comparable diesel tank and fueling system, provided that the
- 15 maximum gross weight of the vehicle or combination of vehicles may
- 16 not exceed 81,000 [82,000] pounds.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
