## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 7 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to commercial drivers' licenses, so as to provide standards for liability of an
- 3 employer or insurance provider for actions relating to a commercial vehicle driver; to provide
- 4 for definitions; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 7 SECTION 1.
- 8 Article 7 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 commercial drivers' licenses, is amended by revising Code Section 40-5-145, relating to
- 10 duties of employer, as follows:
- 11 "40-5-145.
- 12 (a) Each employer shall require every commercial motor vehicle driver applicant to
- provide the information specified in subsection (d) of Code Section 40-5-144.
- 14 (b) No employer may knowingly allow, require, permit, or authorize a driver to drive a
- 15 commercial motor vehicle during any period:

16 (1) In which the driver has a driver's license suspended, revoked, or canceled by a <u>any</u>

- state; has lost the privilege to drive a commercial motor vehicle in a <u>any</u> state; or has been
- disqualified from driving a commercial motor vehicle;
- 19 (2) In which the driver has more than one driver's license;
- 20 (3) In which the driver, or the commercial motor vehicle that he or she is driving, or the
- 21 motor carrier operation, is subject to an out of service order; or
- 22 (4) In violation of a federal, state, or local law or regulation pertaining to
- 23 railroad-highway grade crossings.
- 24 (c)(1) As used in this subsection, the term:
- 25 (A) 'Driver's record' means investigation of a driver's safety performance history
- 26 through an enumeration of accidents and convictions of moving traffic violations as
- 27 <u>provided by the department pursuant to Code Section 40-5-2.</u>
- 28 (B) 'Federal requirements' means the number of years an employer of a commercial
- 29 <u>motor vehicle driver is required to investigate of a driver's record pursuant to federal</u>
- 30 <u>law.</u>
- 31 (2) For purposes of establishing liability of any employer or insurance provider in a civil
- action relating to the holder of a commercial driver's license, use of:
- 33 (A) The driver's record shall be limited to federal requirements; and
- 34 (B) Any vehicle global positioning system data or video recordings, including
- 35 <u>electronic control module data and any onboard electronic recording devices, shall be</u>
- limited to the date an accident or moving violation occurred."

SECTION 2.

38 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
