1 (iii) A misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months one (1) year, a fine of 2 3 not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) one 4 thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00), or both, if the value of the property is less than one thousand dollars 5 (\$1,000.00). 6 7 8 (j) Any person convicted of a fifth third or subsequent offense for theft, shoplifting, larceny, 9 wrongful taking of property, wrongful disposal of property 10 11 or livestock rustling, any other theft offense under this 12 section, any theft offense under a municipal ordinance or any theft offense pursuant to a substantially similar law 13 of another jurisdiction separately brought and tried shall 14 be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not 15 16 more than ten (10) years, a fine of not more than ten 17 thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), or both. 18 19 6-3-411.
