AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in  
relation to requiring  
certain buses and trucks be equipped with  
commercial GPS devices

The People of the State of New York, represented  
in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 375 of the vehicle and traffic  
law is amended by

2 adding a new subdivision 58 to read as follows:

3 58. Every bus, omnibus and commercial truck  
operating upon the public

4 highways of the state, shall be equipped with a  
commercial GPS device.

5 Such GPS device must: (a) allow the capability  
of entering into the

6 device the dimensions of the vehicle, including  
length, width, height

7 and weight; and (b) provide route directions that  
8 account for commercial  
9 truck restrictions such as bridge heights and  
10 clearances, load limits,  
11 one-way road designations, and left-hand  
12 and dangerous turn  
13 restrictions. The GPS device shall be kept in  
14 good operating condition  
15 at all times and must be mounted in a place readily  
16 accessible for use.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth  
13 day after it shall  
14 have become a law. Effective immediately,  
15 the addition, amendment  
16 and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary  
for the implementation  
of this act on its effective date are  
authorized to be made and  
completed on or before such effective date.
